

Thinking Caps!

Pre-K Four-5th Grade

This project will require you to "put on your thinking cap" as you create a fun, three-dimensional hat.

Your "thinking cap" will be created using construction paper or printer paper and a paper plate.

Cut your construction paper into strips. If you do not have construction paper, you can cut printer paper and draw fun lines (with markers or colored pencils) and patterns to add color. Then cut the strips of paper and glue or tape them to a paper plate (the brim of your hat). You will need to glue or tape both ends of the strips of paper - anywhere you would like on the plate. You can also glue strips of paper on top of other strips to make the hat tall!
