

MR. BLANTON'S CHALLENGE: Challenge yourself to complete some of my favorite activities.

- **Quiz** is actually two identical quizzes, one labeled Review and one called Graded. Take the Review quiz first. Then, re-watch the movie and take the Graded quiz to see if your knowledge and score increases. Note: Each quiz has 10 multiple choice questions with 4 possible answers. Use the cursor to click on your answer. If correct, the quiz advances to the next question. Incorrect answers show up immediately with a diagonal line across the answer. Try again until you discover the correct answer before proceeding.
- **Related Readings** is a small collection of 6 interesting articles to read, each with a different focus or format. Review them all first, then select several articles to read. You can read them all if you like.
- **Games** is a group of interactive video games that reinforces knowledge and concepts found in the movie. Narrow down this collection by using three filters (Subjects: Science; Grades: 3-5; Time to Play: choice). Select and play at least 3 games to stretch your mind and use the information you learned from the movie.
